Connect Up

The Connect Up program places Family Services workers within local communities to provide early intervention responses to engage families.

The program in partnership with local schools, kindergartens and the community helps to develop confident parents / caregivers to support their 0-12 year old children to thrive through a range of services at co-located sites such as:

- Brief and short term family support: Providing families with individual early assistance to build confidence and skills to manage parenting challenges
- Linking and referrals: Supporting families to navigate and access the service system e.g. kindergarten to prep transition, health referrals and other support services
- Supported playgroups: Providing an opportunity for parents/caregivers with preschool aged children to interact with one another in an inclusive, safe environment
- Parenting education and engagement groups:
 Facilitating the interaction of parents/caregivers with their local community to discuss topics of interest and facilitate group work programs
- Secondary consultation: Provided to education and wellbeing staff to best meet individual family needs
