School Readiness and Positive Transitions

What is 'School Readiness'? A measure of the knowledge, skills and behaviours that enable children to participate and succeed in school. Relationships are at the core of positive transition to school experiences.

When families, early childhood services, schools and communities work together, the 'whole child' is supported to reach their full learning potential.

Learning objectives:

- Learn about what 'School Readiness' looks like.
- Learn about what to look for when deciding if your child is ready for school.
- Get some tips on preparing for school and how to create a positive transition.
- Get some tips for the first year of school.
