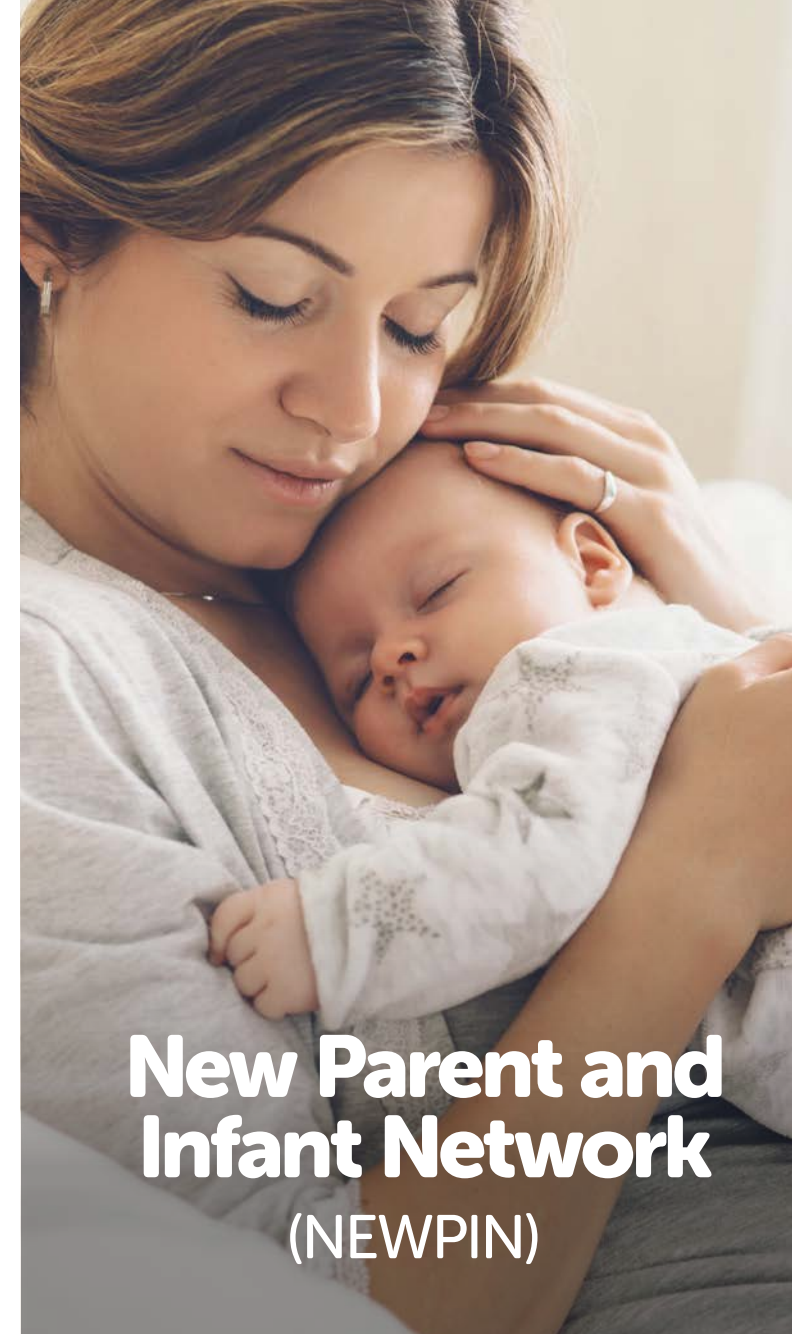

About The NEWPIN Program

The New Parent and Infant Network Program (NEWPIN) is a family services early years program for mothers with children aged 0 – 4 years aiming to:

- Promote positive parent child attachment
- Promote child safety and child development
- Improve social connections for families and
- Develop parenting styles and practices

The program combines centre-based sessions for mothers and their children aged 0 – 4 years, formal and informal group work and individual supports to meet the needs of each family unit.

NEWPIN is underpinned by attachment theory, trauma-informed practice, child development and a culture of safety.

The NEWPIN House

The NEWPIN house provides a welcoming, calm and safe space for mothers and their children to enjoy spending time together – playing and learning together.

Parent and child group work sessions are facilitated at the house on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Mothers and their children attend at least one of these groups per week (unless unwell etc.).
