Safer Families, Safer Communities

The Men's Family Violence Intervention Centre provides a coordinated response, designed to increase accountability of men who choose to use violence in their relationships and mitigate their risk of re offending.

Men's Behaviour Change Group Work

Men's Behaviour Change (MBC) programs address the men's use of family violence through a gendered lens, and places accountability and responsibility to change on the man choosing to use violence.

The group is delivered across 27 sessions.

MBC – Post Participation Group

MBC Post Participation Group will provide an opportunity for men to continue their journey of change and reinforce behaviour change and accountability as previously explored in the MBC program.

Men's Case Management

Case management focuses on the development of an individualised program for male perpetrators and addresses complex needs and assists men to take responsibility for their use of violence and mitigate their risks of re-offending.

Family Safety Contact

Support extends to female partners, ex-partners and children through a Family Safety Contact Worker.

Child Safety
